

**Community Fund Sunday (June 29th).** The Scottish Episcopal Church's Community Fund makes a significant difference to the lives of many people in need in our society. Small and immediate grants are made to those who cannot find help from any other source. The last Sunday in June is designated as Community Fund Sunday, when congregations are invited to contribute. All cash in the plate on 29 June will be given to the Community Fund. If you will not be in church that day, please place any contribution in an envelope, clearly marked 'SEC Community Fund' and place it in the offering plate at any time. Grants are made on the recommendation of clergy or organisations such as Children 1st, One Parent Families Scotland, Circle Scotland and Social Work departments in Scotland, and are promptly processed so that help can be provided quickly. Demand on the Fund is high and can only be expected to increase as State benefits become harder to obtain.
