**First Friday of each month**

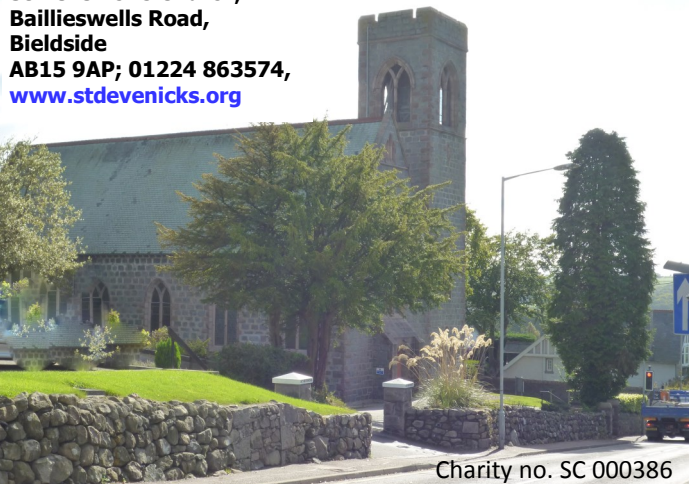
**9.30am in the church.**
