## MIDSUMMER PICNIC at DRUM CASTLE

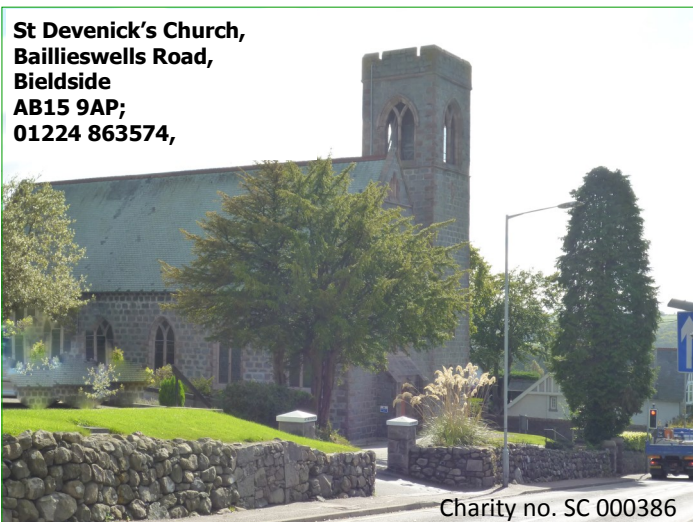
**Sunday June 21st,
